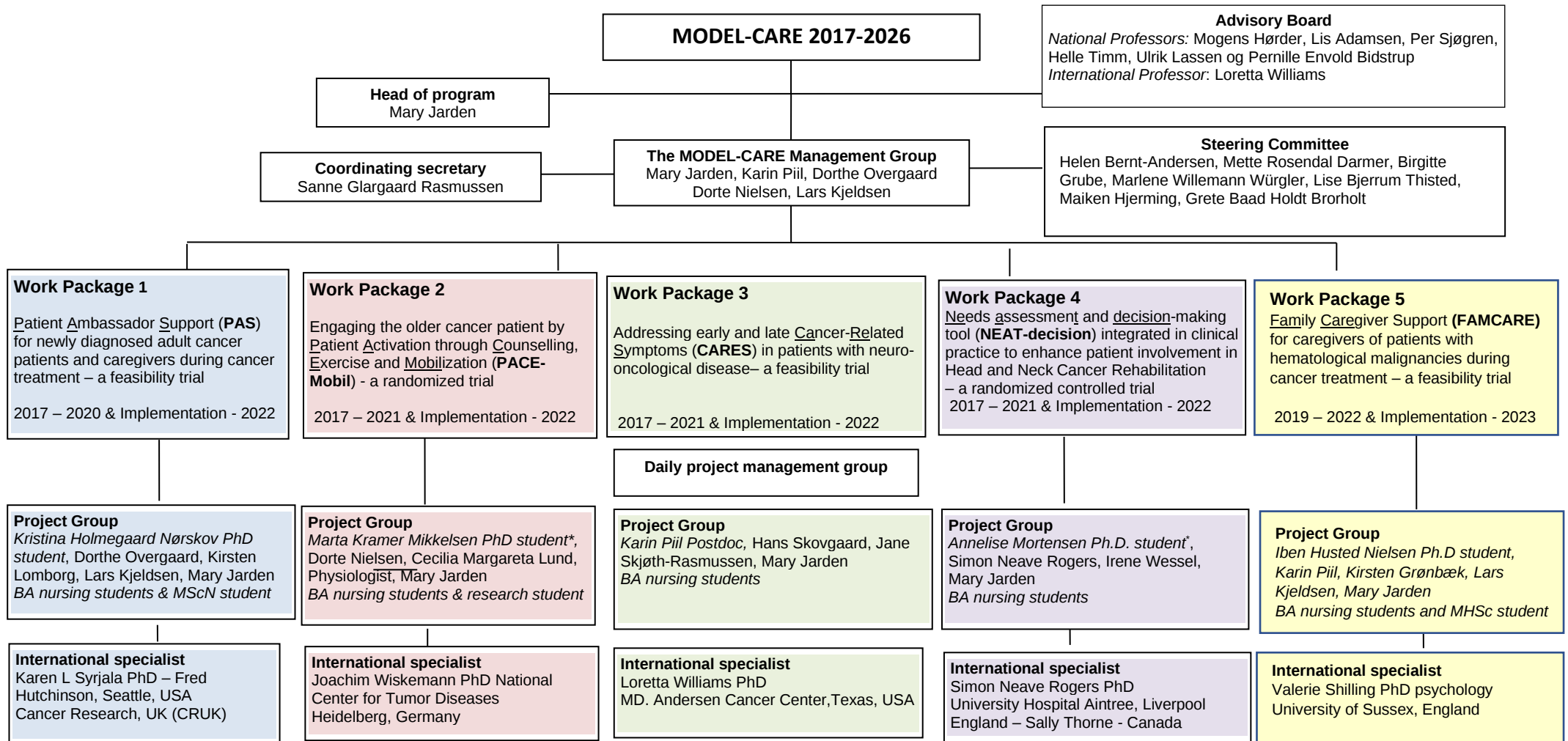

MODEL-CARE management group has joint responsibility to ensure that all projects are managed and carried out according to the written protocols, time schedules, budgets, research ethics and policies.

Advisory board members are renowned scientists (within symptom management, patient involvement, rehabilitation and palliation) that will ensure high international research standards.

Steering committee members hold leadership positions and will make certain that MODEL-CARE is carried out within the interests and goals set by their institution, clinical practice and national strategies for cancer patients.

Daily project management group consists of the four main investigators of each project, the statistician and head of program. The group will meet to discuss and plan common research agenda.

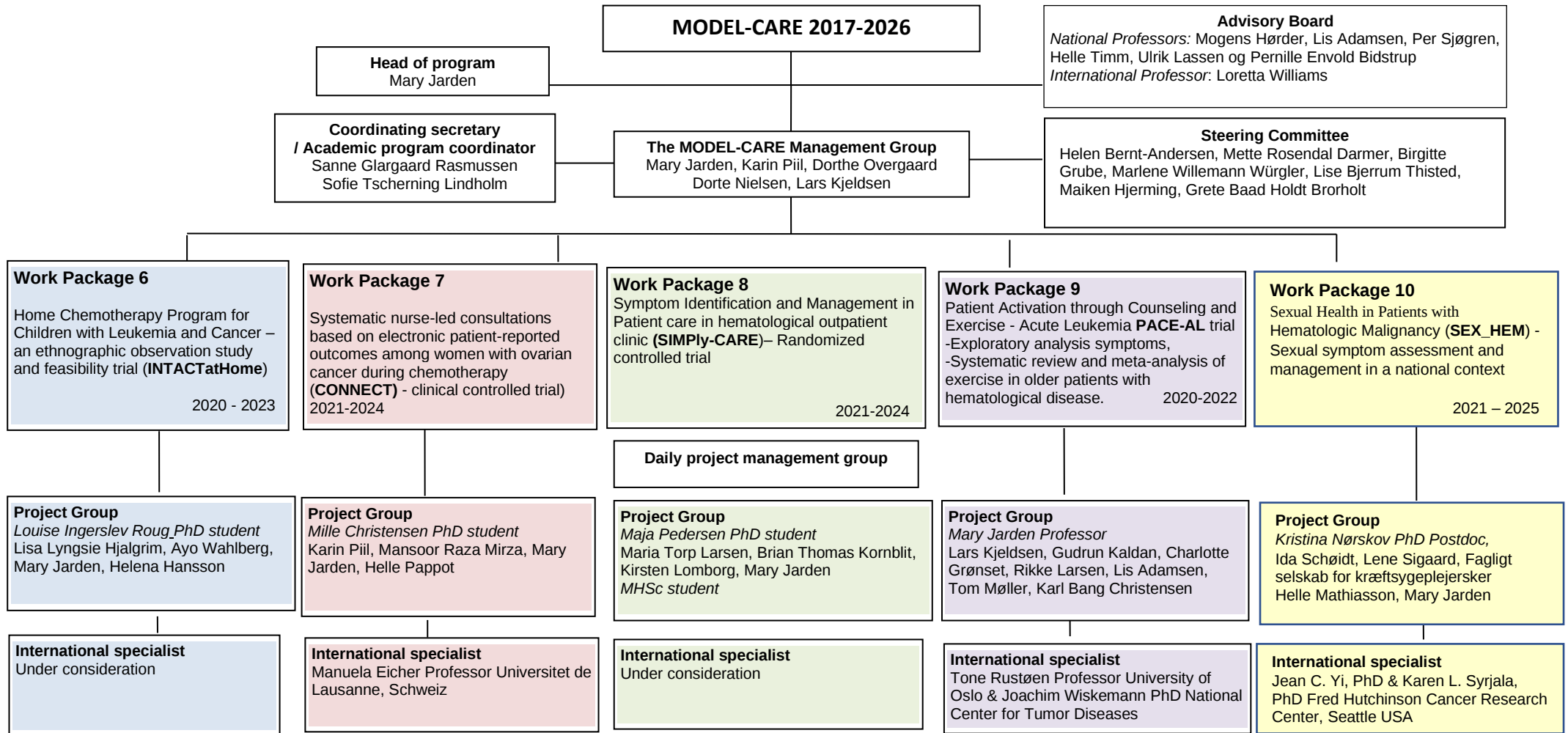
Project group for each MODEL-CARE project will take joint responsibility for the daily execution of the project.

International specialists will share expertise and supervise the project group that they are affiliated with.

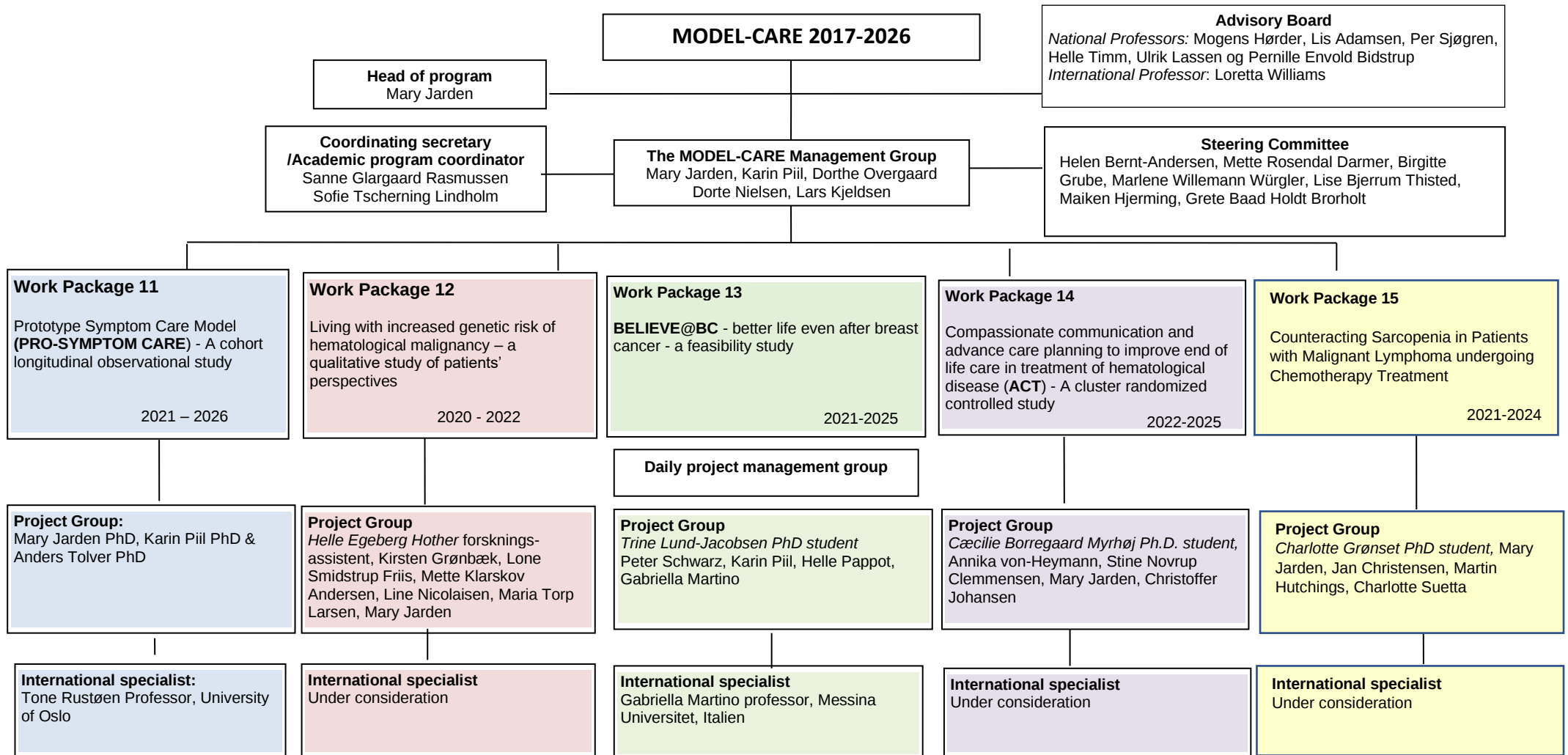
****** Bachelor nursing students from University College Copenhagen (UCC) will be linked to each project through the *bachelor elite and talent program* under the supervision of UCC faculty
