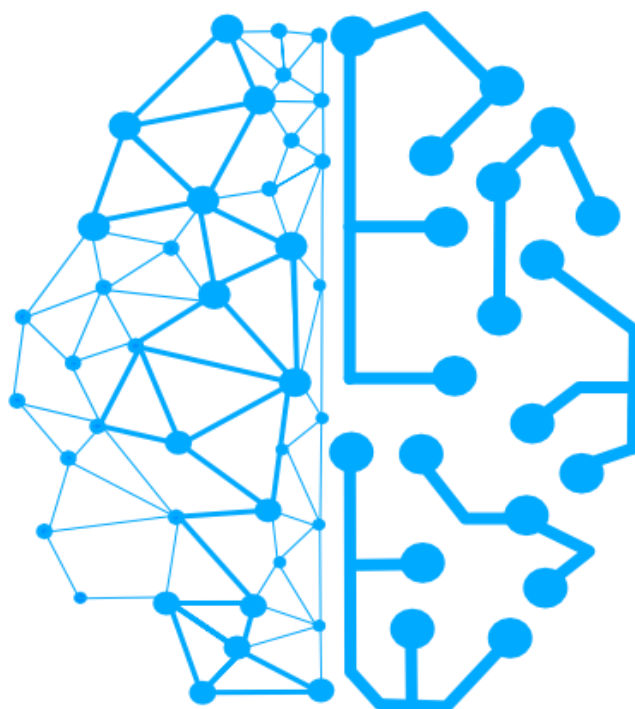

Dear investigators

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to participate in the 2nd International Investigator Meeting of the SafeBoosC III Trial, to be held in Copenhagen, Denmark from the 23rd to 24th of January 2020. Again, we will cover the local costs, but you will have to provide your own transport.

The meeting will have four topics. 1) The processes of getting the trial up and running in each country, 2) How to optimize the quality of the intervention - as it has to be delivered 24/7, 3) How to optimize the quality of the trial - as large-scale trials face several threats, and 4) Ancillary studies.

We plan to benefit from the experiences within the investigator group and therefore will invite some of you to speak. We invite all to contact us if there are specific topics that should be addressed when we are together. There will also be group meetings, where investigators will get a chance to discuss regional matters. We wish this second investigator meeting to serve as a platform to enhance the conduct of the trial, push it forward and strengthen the group, so that we can reach our common goals.

If you wish to participate, please respond to this letter before the 1st of December.

Who will be invited?

All national coordinators and principal investigators are invited to the meeting. The list of national coordinators and principal investigators can be found on www.safeboosc.eu.

Where is the meeting held and will accommodation be provided?

The meeting is held at Comwell Conference Center Copenhagen, Center Boulevard 5, 2100 København S. Accommodation will be provided for all participants from the 23th to 24th of January (check-in from 15:00 the 23th and checkout before 12:00 the 24th) including food and beverages. The hotel is AC Hotel Bella Sky Copenhagen, which offers direct access to Comwell Conference Center. When arriving, go to the reception in the Conference center (see under 'how do we get to the venue from the airport').

For investigators travelling from over-seas, i.e. China and USA, we will provide two nights' accommodation.

How do we get to the venue from the airport?

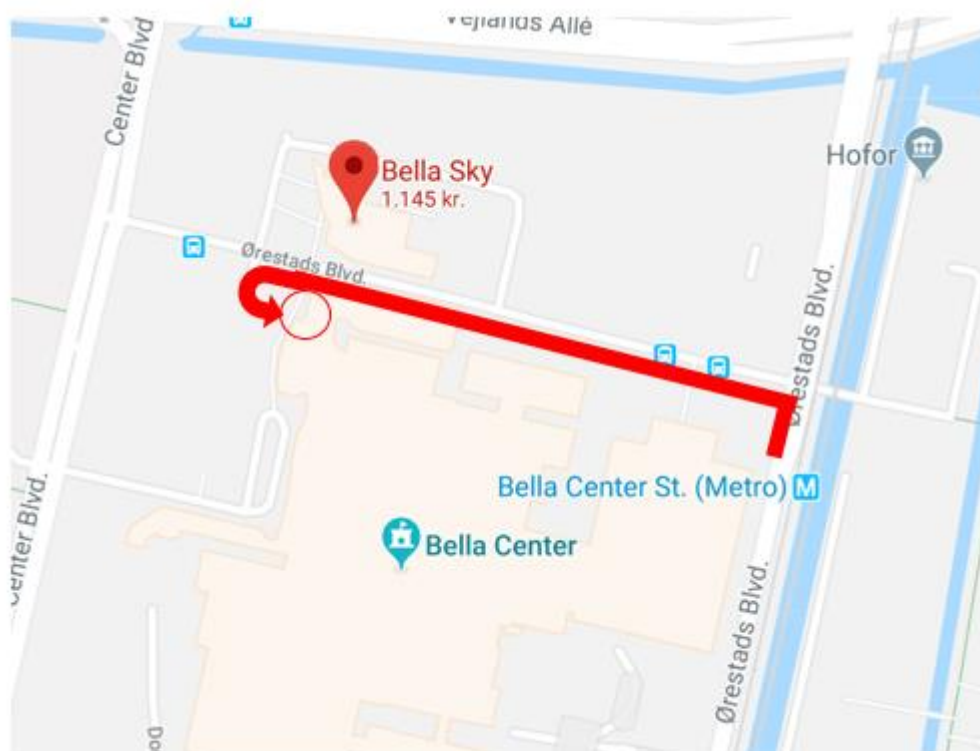
There are multiple ways to transfer from Kastrup airport to the conference center.

Metro – 24 minutes

When arriving in Kastrup airport, go to Terminal 3, where the metro is in direct extension with the airport. It is possible to buy tickets in the ticket machines at the Metro station, using credit card or coins (i.e. you cannot pay with notes) or at “DSB billetsalg” (ticket sales office) in Terminal 3. Please buy a ticket for 3 zones, it costs 36 danish kroner.

Start by taking the metro towards “Vanløse”. On the 7th stop named “Christianshavn”, hop-off the metro and change to the metro towards “Vestamager”. On the 4th stop named “Bella Center” hop-off.

The conference center and hotel is right across the metro station. When exiting the metro station and facing towards the conference center, walk right on Ørestads Boulevard, then left on Ørestads Boulevard for approximately 500 meters. On your left you will find the conference center entrance, use entrance 2 and go to the conference reception (see map).



Regional train and metro – 12 minutes

When arriving in Kastrup airport, go to terminal 3. Tickets can be bought in the ticket machines in terminal 3 (just above the train tracks) or at “DSB billetsalg” (ticket sales office), also in terminal 3. When you buy a ticket in the ticket machines, find the station named “Bella Center station” through the machines search engine, price is 24 danish kroner. You can only pay with credit card or coins.

Start by taking the train from track 2 (all trains from track 2 goes to Copenhagen) and hop-off at “Ørestad station” (second stop). Change here to the metro towards “Vanløse” and hop-off at Bella Center station (first stop). Use the same walking directions as described when taking the metro solely.

Shuttle bus

There is a free shuttle bus from the airport to the conference center from bus-stop number two outside Terminal 2, departing every 30 minutes from 6-23. When leaving the conference, the shuttle bus also departs from the entrance to Bella Sky hotel every 30 minutes from 6-23 and arrives at the airport. The shuttlebus is free for all conference participants.

Will my transportation be paid for?

We will pay for accommodation for all investigators but not transportation.

What to do if I decide to stay longer in Copenhagen?

Copenhagen is a wonderful city with lots of tourist attractions to explore. If you wish to prolong your stay, it is possible to book additional nights through
