

Welcome to the July 2024 issue of the SafeBoosC newsletter.

SafeBoosC-III follow-up

We are in the final phase of the study and many sites have already finished completing data. We have good contact with most sites that have missing data and are hopeful that the data completion percentages will increase these last months. In August, we will complete the first quality data monitoring before the deadline for data completions in October.

With excluded and withdrawn sites, a total of 1163 participants are eligible for the follow up study and have reached two years of corrected age. In total, 819 (70%) of these participants have primary outcome data in OpenClinica, a number which is rising. A total of 717 (62%) families have completed the parental questionnaire and 108 (9%) are lost to follow up. For the participants having reached 30 months of corrected age, 82% have enough data for the primary outcome. An overview of sites with missing data can be found in table 1.

Figure 1: Overall data completion in the SafeBoosC-III follow up study.

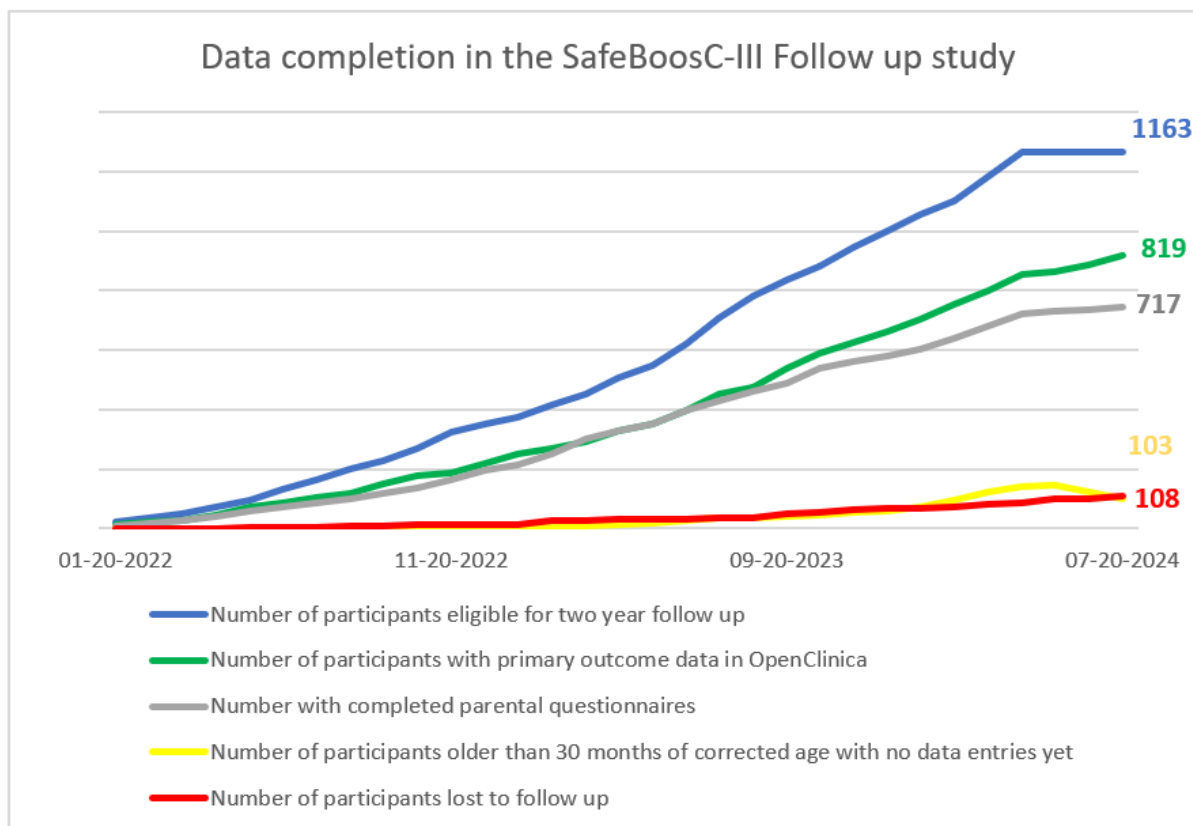
