

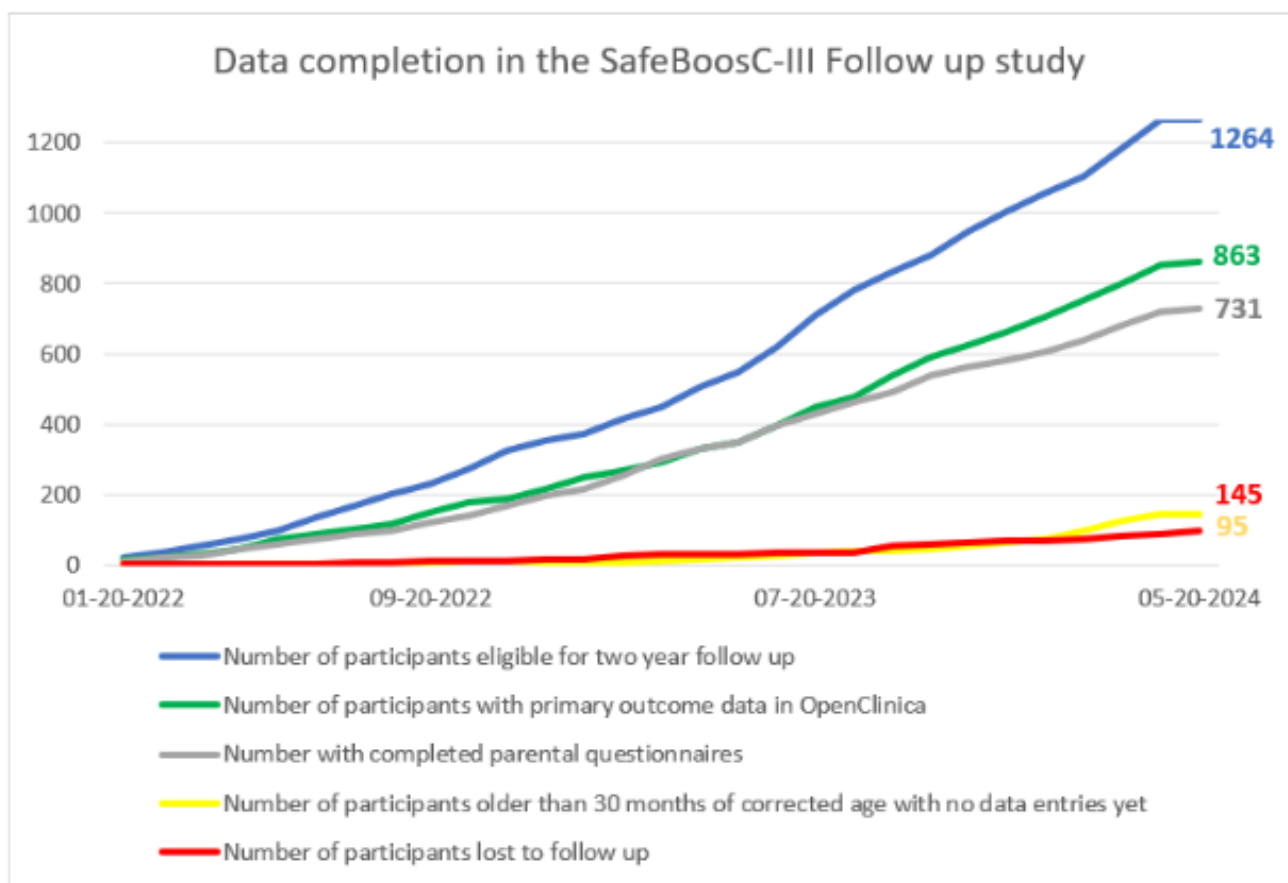


Welcome to the May 2024 issue of the SafeBoosC newsletter.

SafeBoosC-III follow-up

We have entered the final phase of the study and we ask investigators to complete data entry as soon as possible. An SOP describing the final phase of the study can be found [here](#). All eligible infants (n=1264) have reached two years of corrected age. As of now, for 863 (68%) infants data entries in OpenClinica is done and 731 (58%) participants/families have completed the parental questionnaire. For the participants having reached 30 months of corrected age, 82% have enough data for the primary outcome. For a list of sites with missing data please see figure 1.
