1) Central update

Caroline gave an introduction to the central status including number of randomisations, funding, data monitoring, publications etc.

2) Presentation of standard operating procedure

Caroline went through the standard operating procedure on substudies. Caroline explained that the standard operating procedure is available on safeboosc.eu, and investigators are allowed to plan and conduct substudies. All substudies need approval by the Steering Committee. Proposals must be sent to caroline.kamp@ctu.dk. A list of eCRF data points is available on the website.

3) Substudy proposal on early cardiovascular interventions

Kosmas Sarafidis presented a substudy on cerebral oximetry for frequency of early cardiovascular interventions, with the hypothesis that cerebral oximetry will increase the number of cardiovascular interventions. Kosmas outlined the primary outcome, inclusion and exclusion criteria, and methods. The substudy was discussed among the participants of the meeting.

4) Substudy proposal on environmental impact

Johanne Juul Petersen presented a substudy on the environmental impact of treatment guided by cerebral oximetry versus usual care. Johanne outlined the primary outcome, inclusion and exclusion criteria, and methods. A substudy and publication plan will be shared with the Steering Committee.

We will continue working on the substudy protocols in smaller groups. Once they are finalised, they will be shared with all investigators for potential participation.
