The primary outcome data (NIRS) has now been locked in the database and the statistician is running the planned primary analysis.

The compilation and verification of the exploratory data is still ongoing. Cornelia, Manon, and Anne Mette is struggling to complete the central reading of cUS. Some images have not yet been sent to Copenhagen. Please do so ASAP. Also the eCRFs of the last infants need to be in without delays.

This means that we hope to have all data needed for the primary publication ready ready for our spring Dragør meeting on 28-29-April 2014.

Wim has also successfully analysed the blood and urine samples. This is a big success. The statistician is running the planned analysis.

The spring Dragør meeting will have three main topics:

- publication of the primary outcome of the RCT
- adjusting the plans for the remaining work
- deciding on a new clinical trial with European funding.
