The next job is to have all data uploaded, ship blood and urine samples, and have all e-CRFs completed until term date. The verification of the data must be done during the first months of 2014 with the goal of locking the database and run the planned primary analysis so that the results can be ready for our spring Dragør meeting on 28-29-April 2014.

The spring Dragør meeting will have three main topics:

- publication of the primary outcome of the RCT
- adjusting plans for the remaining work, and
- decision on a new clinical trial with European funding.

So please, make sure that you have the dates in your diary. All staff that has been central to the SafeBoosC study is welcome. You pay the flight and we pay the hospitality.
